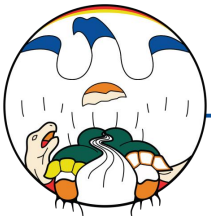
# Project Status

- 85% building information
- 55% road right-of-way assets
- 65% water distribution assets
- 80% field data capture tablets
- 30% ACRS data capture & reporting
- 5% WEB communications
- 75% acquiring Wasauksing imagery
- 50% strategic summary and 2019/2020 funding application
- In process of securing 2019/2020 funding

# Northern Communities Investment Readiness (NCIR) “Open For Business”

- Promote and support the development of the tools and capability for the community to attract, receive and successfully entertain investment opportunities and builds on results of the Investment Readiness Test
- Applications accepted until November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018
- Project must be completed and all claims made by March 2019
- Contribution of 75% up to \$10,000 per community
- Example projects:
  - Investment related workshops and training
  - Investment readiness strategy development (community asset inventory, SWOT analysis, gap analysis)
  - Infrastructure requirement studies
  - Site selection information development
  - Investment priorities identification
  - Development of community profiles
  - Developing and implementing a targeted investment strategy
  - Targeted investment opportunity research
  - In-bound familiarization tours or site visits of potential investors qualified as eligible

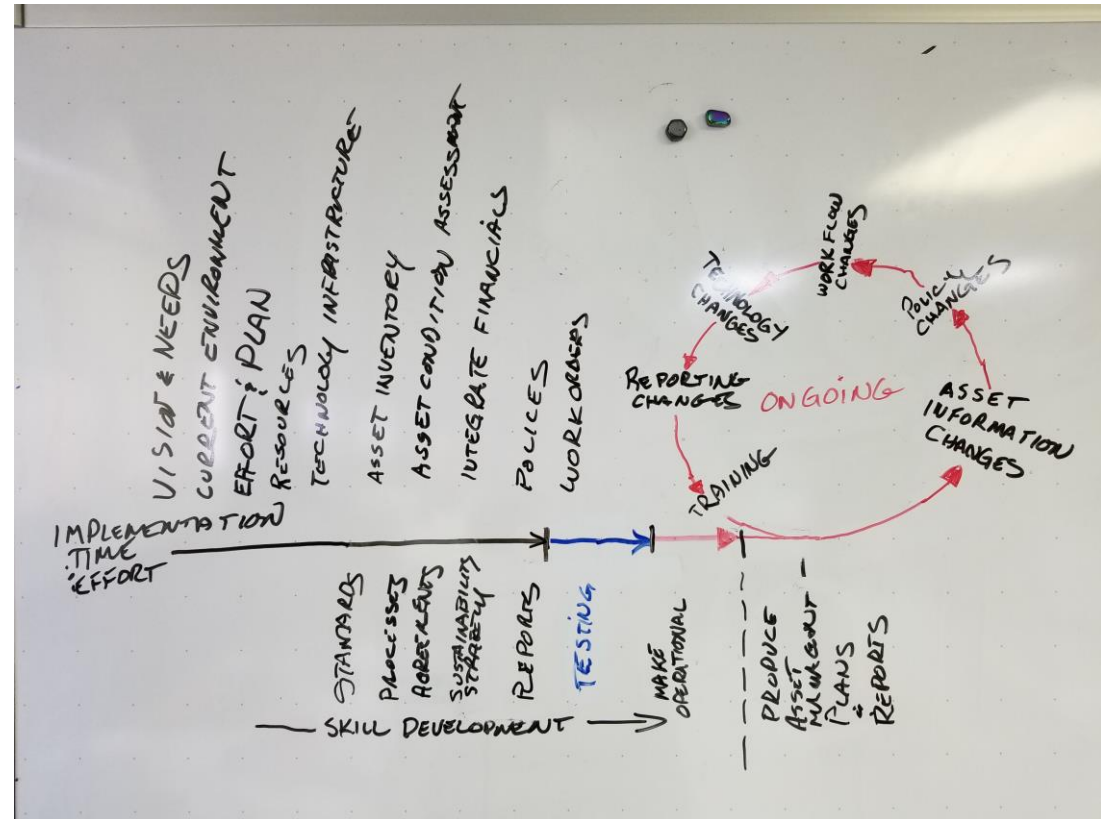
